

# REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS – SOCIAL JUSTICE AND SYSTEMS-CHANGE CONSULTANT

RISE seeks a consultant with proven expertise in the following areas: accessibility and cultural responsiveness in the non-profit service sector, organizational development and collaborative systemschange, and group training/facilitation to advance social justice.

RISE is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization that provides crisis intervention and treatment services to survivors of sexual and intimate partner violence and their loved ones. All services are provided confidentially, at low or no cost, to anyone regardless of age, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, religion, or ability. All client services are available in Spanish and English.

#### **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The selected consultant will work in close collaboration with and in support of the agency's staff, board of directors, and stakeholders in the development of culturally responsive programs and services. We seek a partner with experience in social justice work and a proven track record in non-profit systems-change. The consultant will assist RISE in 1) reviewing existing policies, practices, and protocols that lend themselves to cultural responsiveness and inclusivity; 2) examining organizational gaps in cultural responsiveness and institutional barriers to service access; and 3) developing and engaging staff and board members, clients, and community group representatives in a steering committee charged with addressing those gaps.

Ultimately, RISE aims to gain knowledge and tools to routinely provide space for many and diverse voices, and avenues to allow those voices to shape our policies and programs.

### **SCOPE OF WORK**

The selected consultant will work collaboratively with RISE staff, board of directors, and community stakeholders to:

 Examine existing policies and protocols in order to identify what may be working well, and what could be improved in terms of service access. This process will include a thorough examination of personal and professional privilege, power, and implicit bias among staff and board members, attributes and behaviors that may lend themselves to exclusionary practices.

- 2. Develop a culturally responsive and accessible survey tool in order to analyze RISE's ability to communicate with clients in their preferred language, meet diverse needs, and promote a welcoming, safe, and respectful environment.
- 3. Form a steering committee staffed by recruits from RISE staff and board, clients, and representatives from community groups. Consultant will work with the steering committee to explore existing tools and resources utilized by other service and community-based agencies to promote cultural responsiveness, and will develop a short- and long-term plan to address gaps moving forward.

### **PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS**

Please include the following in your application:

- A resume and short biography.
- A 1-2 page proposal detailing your approach and process for facilitating organizational culture shifts and systems-change. Include a brief narrative describing your vision for RISE.
- A 1-2 page case study of similar consultation services you have provided in the past. Describe services provided and outcomes.
- References: Supply three (3) references that have used your professional services for a similar project. Include a contact name, address, and phone number.

## **PROJECT BUDGET**

Funds will cover fees for service and travel expenses. RISE will cover the cost of supplies, printing needs, copier costs, and any other necessary materials during the training and implementation process up to \$1,500. Contractor is responsible for materials and supplies costs beyond \$1,500.
